Whelan Award recognizes a younger quality professional who has displayed distinguished performance in a sustained role as an organizational leader and has significantly advanced educational programs in the key principles of quality within the world-wide fraternity of quality professionals and community at large. This language will be on the recipient's certificate and the "perpetual plaque".

Thus, significant achievements of a quality professional under the age of 50 as a leader in a section, discussion group, interest group, forum, or division of ASQ and who has promoted new or enhanced educational opportunities for the world-wide fraternity of quality professionals are expected. It is expected that the recipient will also have contributed to the community beyond the ASQ community.

The Biomedical Division Nominating Committee expects each candidate to excel (i.e. reach level five) in at least one area, perhaps even two. With these guidelines in mind, evaluate each category of the nomination and enter the numerical evaluation on the evaluation sheet.

On a separate page, describe the nominee's accomplishments in each of the four categories, with special emphasis on education and course development.

### I. Publications, Papers, Talks, especially related to education:

- 1= Contributor to Biofeedback
- 2= Contributor to Discussion Group content.
- 3=Contributor to WCQI and division conferences.
- 4=Publication of journal articles.
- 5=Publication of recognized books and texts.

### II. Division, Section, Society, and other professional organization activities :

- 1=Member of division committees.
- 2=Chairman of division committees.
- 3=Member of Division Council
- 4= Division officer or Chair or similar in other professional organization
- 5= Society elected officer or similar in other professional organization

### III. Leadership

- 1=Volunteer for Division Activities
- 2=Participation in DAC Leadership Training
- 3= Participation in WCQI activities
- 4=Leadership of DAC activities or leadership of education in quality in other organizations
- 5=Participation in organization Boards and Committees related to quality and education

### IV. Contribution to education programs

- 1=Volunteer for Division education Activities
- 2=Participation in DAC education Leadership Training
- 3=Participation in WCQI education activities
- 4=Leadership of development and deployment of biomedical education activities
- 5=Participation in Society level education Boards and Committees including Learning Offerings courses or other organization education opportunities.
