



Call for Editor Nominations:

ASQ's Software Quality Professional

Overview:

The American Society for Quality invites nominations for the position of Editor of its journal *Software Quality Professional (SQP)*. This peer-reviewed quarterly journal publishes case studies, experience-based reports, and state-of-the-art reviews in order to provide practitioners with an understanding of those software quality practices that have proven effective in a wide range of industries, applications, and organizational settings.

Its content is intended to give readers a working understanding of how software quality practices are used successfully by supporting theory with real-world accounts of how to implement the processes described. Articles are mapped to corresponding topics within the **body of knowledge for ASQ-certified software quality engineers**.

Responsibilities:

The editor's primary duties will include exercising overall editorial responsibility for each issue (print and web editions), maintaining a qualified Editorial Review Board, recruiting authors, overseeing the submission and peer review of suitable works, adhering to publishing deadlines, and building awareness of *SQP* at industry conferences and through social media.

Nominate:

Candidates interested in applying are invited to provide the Editor Search Committee a curriculum vitae (CV) and their detailed vision for *SQP* during their tenure. The new editor will be selected by ASQ's Publications Management Board upon receiving recommendations from the Editor Search Committee and will begin a 3-year term in January 2017.
