Test Design Strategies

So you've received, yet again, another requirements document that's confusing, incomplete, and ambiguous. And somehow, you have to translate this mess into software designs and test cases. It's not all that difficult if you know how to model requirements. Louise Tamres describes several test design techniques that pinpoint the key features and their intended behavior. In fact, once you've applied these techniques, test cases practically write themselves. These same techniques can also assist developers to identify the key functionality to implement.

Ms. Tamres has established software quality initiatives at many companies, including GE Medical Systems, General Motors, Nortel, Electro Scientific Industries, as well as assisting start-up companies with their software quality needs. She is the founding member of Ann Arbor Software Quality Professionals, a group based in southeastern Michigan. Her frequent role in mentoring fledgling testers led to the development of her book /Introducing Software Testing /published by Addison-Wesley. As part of the ASQ, Ms. Tamres is a Certified Software Quality Engineer, a member of the editorial board for /Software Quality Professional/, and the Councilor for Region 10. Ms. Tamres received her BS and MS degrees from the University of Michigan.
