



Joseph M. Juran Medal

For Distinguished Performance in Quality Leadership

The Juran Medal, named after Dr. Joseph M. Juran, recognizes leaders who accept the challenge of continuous improvement and who exhibit distinguished performance in a sustained role of organizational leader, personally practicing the key principles of quality and demonstrating “breakthrough management” by their exemplary service. This recognition will be reserved for members of the most senior executive level who operate by directing the strategic focus of a major organization. It is intended that this recognition be accorded only to those top leaders whose organizations have clearly and consistently demonstrated exceptional performance through quality methods and practices. Whereas awards like the Malcolm Baldrige National Quality Award provide recognition for the group effort, this medal is intended to provide specific concentration on recognition of the actions of the organization’s leader. It is unlikely that any of the potential nominees for this recognition would be members of a quality professional society, so this will not be a pre-requisite for consideration.

Criteria for Selection

1. Must be chief executive of a company that has received national or international recognition for business improvement based on the body of knowledge of quality management.
2. Must have served continuously as the chief executive for a period of five or more years after establishing the quality direction or strategy.
3. Must demonstrate sustained excellence in business performance in their tenure as chief executive officer.
4. Must serve society as a public promoter of quality leadership with their executive colleagues and through other public venues.
5. Must demonstrate a personal leadership role model that would be compelling to other chief executives for consideration of business strategies based on the chief cornerstone of quality improvement.

Recognition

This recognition accorded this medal will be in the form of a certificate that presents a brief citation describing the recipient’s personal contribution and a medal that is struck with a likeness of Dr. Juran on one side and a prominent symbol that illustrates a major factor in Dr. Juran’s work on the obverse side of the medal surrounded by the words summarizing the recognition: “For Distinguished Performance in Quality Leadership.”
